Cultivation License Requirements



CANOPY SIZE CALCULATION

- ✱ Only Mature Plants
(greater than ½ inch pistil mass)
- ✱ Calculated in Square Feet
 - * except specialty cottage indoor
- ✱ Can be noncontiguous
- ✱ All levels, mezzanines, shelves, trays, etc. count toward total canopy calculation



DETERMINATION OF LIGHT SOURCE

- ✱ Outdoor: No artificial light for Mature Plants
 - ✱ Artificial lighting is permitted during clone and veg
- ✱ Mixed-Light: Cultivation in any of the following
 - ✱ Greenhouse
 - ✱ hoop-house
 - ✱ Glasshouse
 - ✱ Conservatory
 - ✱ Hothouse
 - ✱ structure that uses light deprivation and/or artificial lighting
- ✱ Mixed-Light Tier 1: 6 watts per square foot or less
- ✱ Mixed-Light Tier 2: 6 – 25 watts per square foot
- ✱ Indoor: Exclusive use of artificial light or 25+ watts per square foot

- ✳ Attestation re Labor Peace Agreement (20+ employees)
- ✳ Attestation that applicant is an agricultural employer
- ✳ Attestation that local fire department has been notified of the cultivation site
- ✳ Sovereign immunity if tribe or other sovereign entity

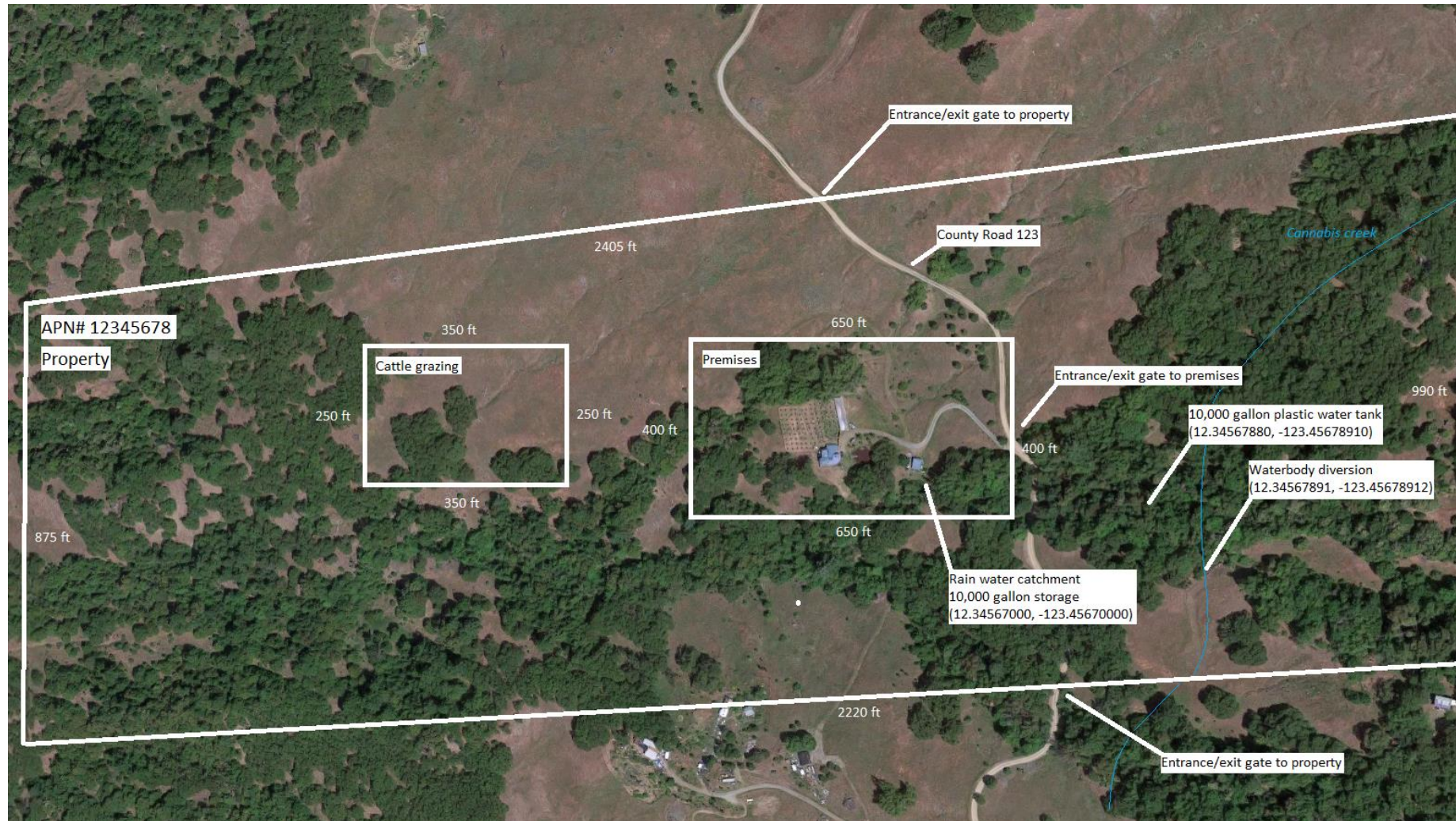

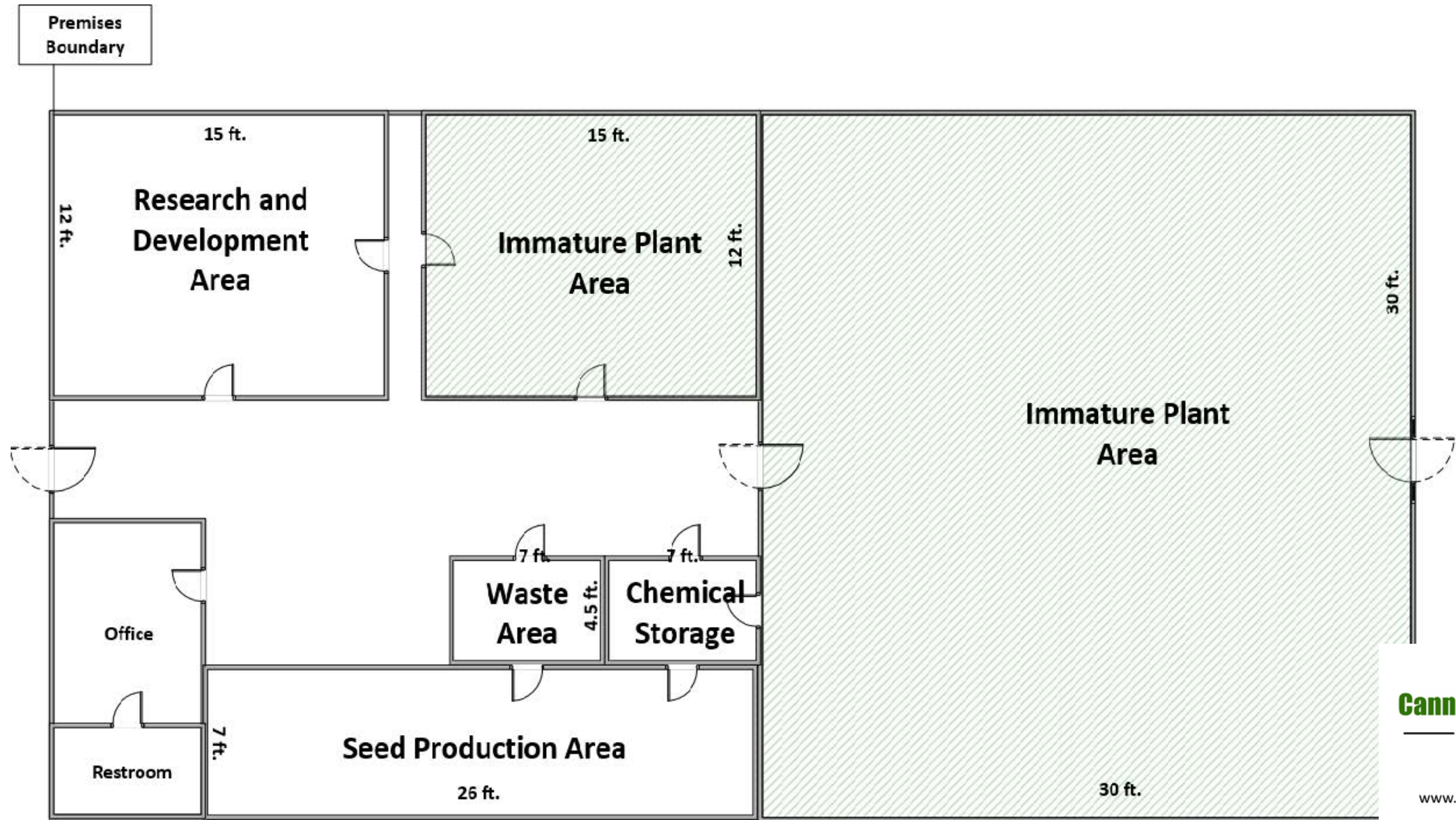

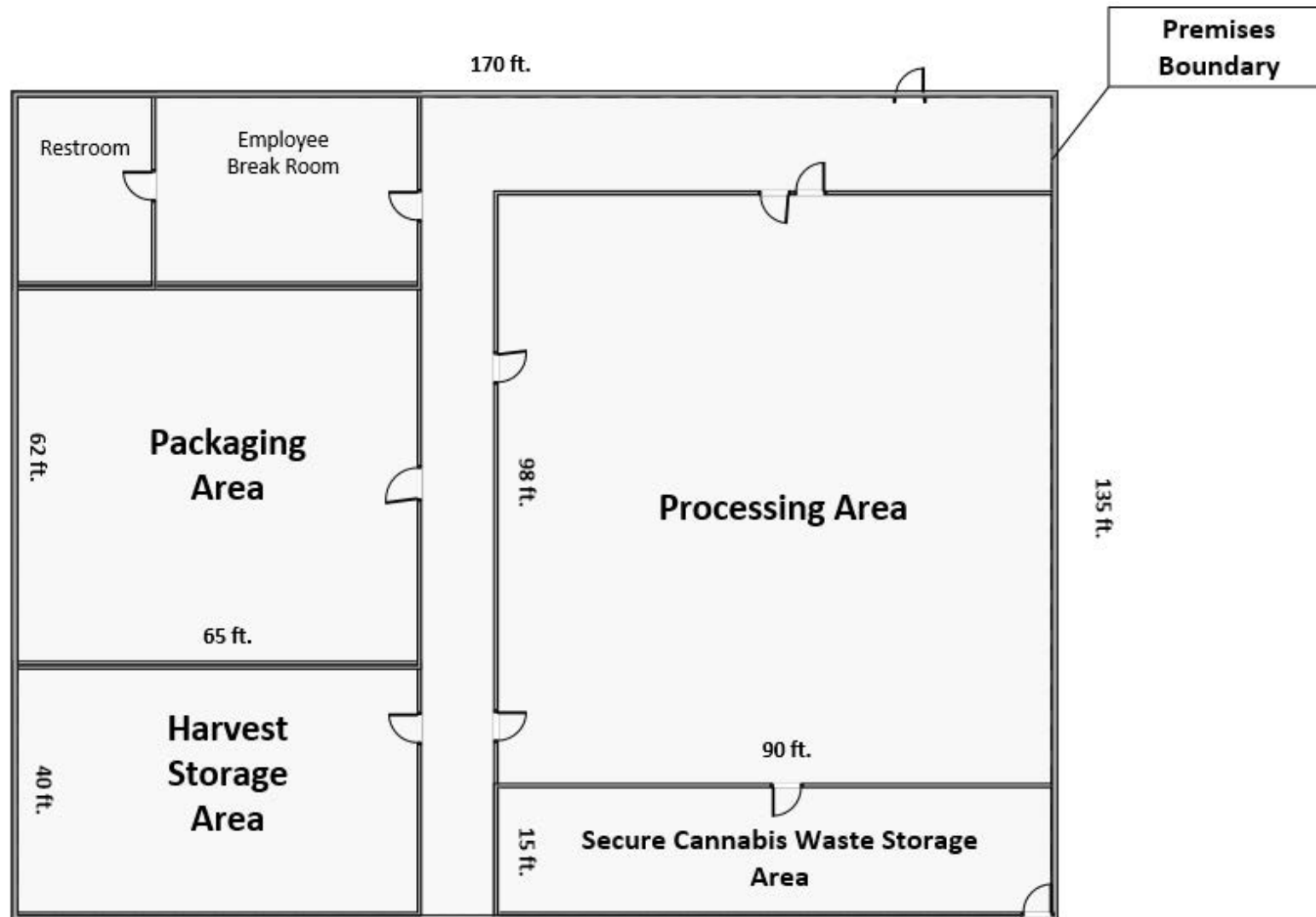

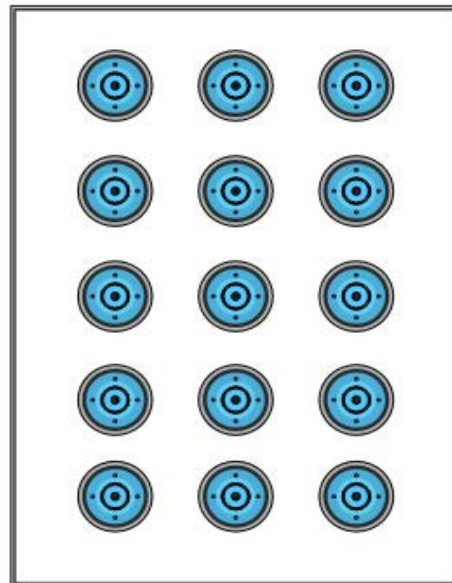


LIGHTING DIAGRAM

Lighting Diagram

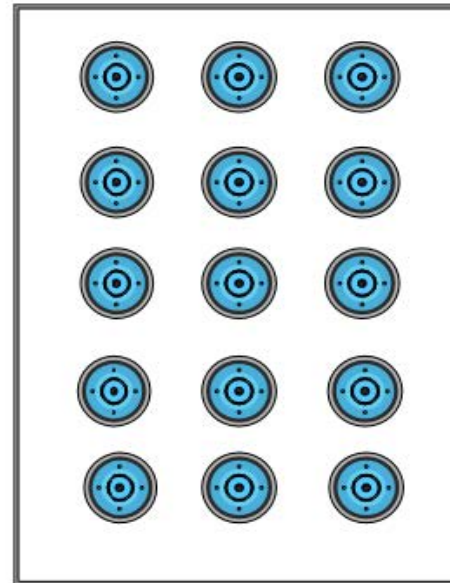
Canopy Area 1 (identified in the premises diagram as greenhouse 1)




Aggregate Wattage per Canopy Area

15 lights X 1200 watts per light = 18,000 watts
Each canopy area (greenhouse) is 1,500 square feet
18,000 watts / 1,500 square feet = **12 watts/square foot**

Canopy Area 2 (identified in the premises diagram as greenhouse 2)



Maximum Wattage of Each Light

 = 1200 maximum watt light

WATER AND WILDLIFE



WATER SOURCE INFORMATION

- ✳ Maximum amount of water delivered to the applicant for cannabis cultivation in any year; and
- ✳ Well log filed with the Department of Water Resources pursuant to section 13751 of the Water Code for each percolating groundwater well used to divert water delivered to the applicant.
 - ✳ If no well log is available, the applicant shall provide evidence from the Department of Water Resources indicating the Department does not have a record of the well log. When no well log is available, the State Water Resources Control Board may request additional information about the well.
- ✳ Groundwater Well – Keep a Well Log!
- ✳ Rainwater catchment system
- ✳ Over water diversion system

FISH & WILDLIFE LSA

- ✱ Fish & Wildlife – LSA (lake and stream bed alteration agreement) or exemption document
- ✱ Covered Activity is:
 - ✱ construction, reconstruction, maintenance, or repair of a Stream Crossing or Water Diversion that is used or will be used for the purpose of Cannabis Cultivation for which the Entity is seeking authorization under the General Agreement.
- ✱ The Covered Activity will not occur on or in a finfish stream or lake.
- ✱ The Covered Activity will not result in take of a Listed or Fully Protected Species.
- ✱ The Covered Activity is not the subject of a complaint or order by CDFW under Section 12025 of the Fish and Game Code, a complaint filed by a city attorney, District Attorney, the Attorney General, or an order by a court.
- ✱ Address any Violations
- ✱ Applicable measures and requirements in subsections (h)-(k) of the General Agreement will be met.



FISH & WILDLIFE DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

- ✱ Biological Resources Assessment – survey and biological resource report by a biologist identifying the presence or potential presence of any species of Greater Conservation Need and finfish and their habitats and invasive species
- ✱ Design Plans – description of site-specific design for construction or reconstruction of a stream crossing or reservoir by a licensed professional
 - ✱ Must include drawings, sizing methods, component details, and construction notes that give specific directions on the construction methods that will be employed for the work.

 - ✱ The location of the Project Site on the Property.

WEIGHMASTER



WEIGHMASTER

- If you want to weigh your cannabis, you **MUST** have a Weighmaster License
 - Accuracy
 - Protects buyers
 - Promotes equality
- Only Licensed Weighmasters may issue a Weighmaster Certificate
- Weighmaster Certificate is needed for transfer to a distributor



PURCHASING & REGISTERING A SCALE

- ✱ A business needs to determine weight of:
 - ✱ containers/packages of trimmings,
 - ✱ containers/packages of product, and
 - ✱ packages of dried flower.
- ✱ These different types of containers and packages will likely require scales of different capacities and division sizes due to basic suitability requirements.
- ✱ Purchase scale from a dealer or online
 - ✱ All scales must be calibrated
- ✱ Use a Registered Service Agency (RSA) to aid in selection of scale appropriate for your business.
- ✱ RSA can also assist with scale registration process

TRACK AND TRACE

- Register with Metrc within 10 days of ANNUAL application being deemed complete
- Provide documentation of training completion within 10 days

DENIALS



Criminal Convictions as Grounds for Denial



- a. Violent felony Penal Code §667.5
- b. Serious felony Penal Code §1192.7
- c. Felony involving fraud, deceit or embezzlement
- d. Felony involving hiring, employment, or use of children in transporting, carrying, selling, giving away, preparing for sale or peddling any controlled substance to a minor, or offering, furnishing, or selling any controlled substance to a minor
- e. Felony for drug trafficking with enhancements under Health & Safety Code §11370.4 or 11379.8
- f. Notwithstanding the above, if the sentence for a controlled substance related conviction is completed for possession of, possession for sale, sale, manufacture, transportation, or cultivation of a controlled substance – this is not to be considered substantially related and not the sole ground for denial.
- g. Conviction following licensing is grounds for revocation and denial of a renewal
- h. Appeal is available if denied

Notice of Denial

- Reasons stated by department
- Reasons can include
 - Criminal history
 - Premises not compliant
 - Denied department access to premises
 - Material misrepresentation
 - Other license was denied
 - Delinquent fees owed to department
- 30 days to file petition

DENIED

RENEWALS AND TRANSFERS



Renewals

- Due not less than 30 days, but not more than 60 days before expiration of current license
 - 50% additional late fee if submitted less than 30 days before expiration until 30 days after expiration
 - New application required if submitted after
- May continue to operate if within the proper time frame until renewal is issued
- Renewal Application
 - Licensee name
 - Number and expiration
 - Mailing and premises address
 - Fee
 - Changes to the prior application with supporting documentation
 - Attestation that all info is accurate and current
- As of January 1, 2022 – for each power source
 - i. Total electricity supplied
 - 1. Utility provided name
 - 2. Greenhouse gas emissions intensity per kwh for prior year

LABOR LAW APPLIES TO ALL EMPLOYERS

- ✱ Labor Code 147.6 – No smoking at work in enclosed areas or where tobacco smoking is prohibited
- ✱ Injury and Illness Prevention
- ✱ Repetitive Motion
- ✱ No Smoking
- ✱ Per MAUCRSA employees who work for cannabis cultivators are NOT covered by IWC 14 – Agricultural Workers; they are covered by IWC 4
 - ✱ IWC 4-2001 Must Be Posted
 - ✱ Alternative Workweek Election and Adoption Procedure (10 hr/day not to exceed 40 hr/week)
- ✱ Minimum Wage and Overtime
 - ✱ Commissions – OT does not apply if the employee makes at least 1.5 x minimum wage AND
 - ✱ At least 50% of pay is commission
- ✱ Worker's Compensation
- ✱ Health Insurance
